

2023 Highlights

- Brought back the Community Health Fair to provide community outreach and vital medical screenings
- Provided a 3% Cost of Living Raise to remain consistent with inflation
- Proudly supported 29 Community Events
- Took steps to implement on-site security,
 7 days/week during the evenings/nights when other resources are less available to combat the violence experienced by the healthcare workforce
- Opened Infusion Clinic to 5 days per week to better serve a growing population

- Participated in the Yampa Valley Regional Airport, multi-agency, live action drill
- Turnover continues to decline. In 2022, the annual employee turnover was 29% and we ended 2023 with 24% turnover (industry standard is 23%)
- Implemented a robust cyber-security program to ensure that patient and employee data remains safe
- Reduced the number of travelers from 19 to 9, which equates to about \$1.5 million in annual savings
- Volunteered to provide and serve meals at St. Michael's Community Kitchen

Population Health

In 2023, MRH's Care Coordination team documented **1,151 patient encounters across 543 unique patients**. The Care Coordination team provided community members assistance in regard to food insecurity, housing instability, transportation assistance for rides in-town and out-of-town to medical appointments; helping patients access preventive health care services; and improve health outcomes by providing patient navigation services for patients struggling to manage chronic health conditions. Additionally, through generous financial support



from the City of Craig Housing & Food Grant and the Moffat County United Way Human Resources Coalition (HRC) grant funding, MRH invested \$18,167 back into the community by providing direct assistance to people needing help paying for a variety of social and health needs. MRH also established an in-house food pantry, to ensure no patient goes home hungry, while other resources are put in place for long-term support for nutrition resources.
